SELECTION PROCEDURE

5.1. Syllabus & Modalities

Syllabus for Stage-I and Stage-II Offline Written Examination (on O.M.R. sheet) for Category 'D' cadre posts:

- There shall be no negative marking for incorrect answers.
- The question paper will be available in both English and Hindi language
- In case of any discrepancies between the English and Hindi versions of the Question Paper, the English version will be considered final.
- Questions shall be on the areas related to and of the level mentioned in essential qualification.
- The Selection Committee has discretion to fix minimum qualifying marks in any or all parts of papers in both the stages i.e. in Stage-I & II (Written Examination).

Selection Procedure: The selection procedure shall include the following two stages:-

(i) Stage-I Written Examination:- Open competitive examination (offline) will be held at various districts of Uttar Pradesh. This test shall consist of 100 objective type questions to be answered on OMR sheet. Five candidates in order of merit of Stage-I (Written Examination) shall be shortlisted category/sub category-wise against each notified vacancy for appearing in Stage-II (Written Examination) which will be conducted on a later date.

(ii) Stage-II Written Examination:- On the basis of marks scored in Stage-I (Written Examination) five candidates against each vacancy category/sub category-wise shall be shortlisted to participate in Stage-II (Written Examination). This test shall also be objective type consisting 100 questions to be answered on OMR sheets.

(iii) Interview shall not be the part of selection process.

(iv) A combined merit list for all Category 'D' posts shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in Stage-I (Written Examination) and Stage-II (Written Examination).

**Notwithstanding anything contrary in these rules the Appointing Authority and the Selecting Authority with regard to conduct of examination and selection shall act in accordance with general or special orders issued by Hon'ble the Chief Justice of High Court from time to time.*

	<i>(ii) Each correct answer shall carry One (01) Mark.</i>
	<i>(iii) There is no negative marking for incorrect answers.</i>
	<i>(iv) No marks will be given for questions un-answered/ un-attempted.</i>
	<i>(v) If a question is found to be incorrect or ambiguous or having more than one answer during the Key Challenge, only those candidates who have attempted the question and chosen one of the correct answers shall be given the mark.</i>
	<i>(vi) In case a Question is dropped due to some technical mistake (error) or any other reason full marks shall be given to all the candidates.</i>
